NOTICE OF RATE CODE UPDATE TO THE JACKSON COUNTY HOTEL AND MOTEL TAX EFFECTIVE WITH DECEMBER 2021 FILING PERIOD

There is currently a two percent (2%) tax imposed on the gross proceeds from room rentals of hotels and motels located in Jackson County. Businesses subject to this tax currently use rate code 92 to report this activity. Beginning with the December 2021 filing period, you should use rate code 99 to report the two percent (2%) Jackson County Hotel Tax.

*** Note - This is not a new levy. This is strictly a rate code change to an existing levy.

IMPORTANT: These hotel and restaurant special taxes are in addition to the regular seven percent (7%) retail rate of tax. Please refer to the tables below for the appropriate rate code(s) hotels and restaurants located in Jackson County should use to report the special taxes:
