This exemption is from Miss. Code Ann. Section 27-65-103(b). Section 106 explains the exemption on potting soil, mulch and other soil amendments used in growing certain plants. This exemption is from Miss. Code Ann. Section 27-65-111(m). Other minor changes were made. Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 27-65-93, "(1) The commissioner shall, from time to time, promulgate rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the provisions of the sales tax law, for making returns and for the ascertainment, assessment and collection of the tax imposed by the sales tax law as he may deem necessary to enforce its provisions."
