The Department of Revenue (referred to as “DOR” or “Department”) requested sealed bids to cover the materials, manufacturing, performance characteristics, security and warranty marks, quality, testing, packaging, storage, and delivery of finished license tags to the State of Mississippi.

DOR will contract for these services with a single vendor for a contract period beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2022. At the discretion of the License Tag Commission, the duration may be extended up to thirty-six (36) additional months or to June 30, 2025.

DOR released the MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS (IFB) # 2020-02 on February 21, 2020. In response to the IFB, DOR received one (1) sealed bid.

The following vendor submitted a response to the above solicitation:

Your request for debriefing must be received within three (3) business days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **April 10, 2020**. MDOR reserves the right to conduct any such debriefing via a teleconference.

Vendors are reminded that any protests of this decision must be submitted to **Erica Green Greenwood, Contract Analyst, SR** within seven (7) calendar days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **April 14, 2020**. The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of

the protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known), and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful vendor is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
