Short explanation of rule/amendment/pepeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/pepeal: Paragraphs 100, number 2 was reworded to include "champagne", while number 3 lists requirements that must be met in order for a patron to move one bottle of wine from the premises to a wet area. Paragraph 102 was added explaining that it is the on-premises permittee's responsibility to prohibit patrons from entering or leaving the premises with an alcoholic beverage. Paragraph 103 was added to address leaving the premises with an alcoholic beverage in a Leisure Recreation District. Other minor changes were made as well.

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 67-1-37(h), "To adopt and promulgate, repeal and amend, such rules, regulations, standards, requirements and orders, not inconsistent with this chapter or any law of this state or of the United States, as it deems necessary to control the manufacture, importation, transportation, distribution and sale of alcoholic liquor, whether intended for beverage or nonbeverage use in a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter or any other statute, including the native wine laws."
