**UPDATED NOTICE TO ALL TAXPAYERS SUBJECT TO THE
PASCAGOULA TOURISM AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TAX FOR
THE CITY OF PASCAGOULA**

The Pascagoula Tourism and Economic Development tax is no longer in effect as of July 1, 2017. This special tax is levied at the rate of three percent (3%) on the gross proceeds of hotels, motels and bed and breakfasts in the City of Pascagoula. Please discontinue collecting the three percent (3%) tax on hotels, motels and bed and breakfasts, as of July 1, 2017.

All Pascagoula Tourism and Economic Development tax collected after June 30, 2017 must either be:

- Remitted to the Department of Revenue on your next sales tax return.
- Refunded to your customer.

You are required to maintain documentation of refunds to customers for a period of at least thirty-six months.

****Note – The Pascagoula Parks and Recreation Tax is still in effect. Please continue to collect and remit the two percent (2%) tax on restaurants in the City of Pascagoula using rate code 92. In addition, hotels and motels in Pascagoula should continue to collect the 2% Jackson County Hotel and Motel tax using rate code 99.**
