The undersigned Purchaser or Authorized Representative thereof, does hereby certify that the above listed equipment will be registered under the International Registration Plan (IRP) or other similar agreements, for use in interstate commerce. Under Section §27-65-101(1)(ss), Mississippi Code of 1972, retail sales of truck-tractors and semitrailers used in interstate commerce and registered under the International Registration Plan (IRP) or any similar reciprocity agreement or compact relating to the proportional registration of commercial vehicles entered into as provided for in Section §27-19-143 are exempt from sales tax.

The undersigned Purchaser further does certify that if failure to register the above listed equipment under the International Registration Plan (IRP), the Purchaser will pay to the Mississippi Department of Revenue the three percent (3%) sales tax, plus a fifty percent (50%) fraud penalty and the applicable rate of interest per month provided in Miss. Code Ann. § 27-65-39, from the date of purchase until this tax is paid to the Mississippi Department of Revenue.

Any person who willfully attempts in any manner to evade or defeat any tax imposed by the Mississippi Department of Revenue or assists in the evading of that tax or payment thereof, shall in addition to the other penalties provided by law, be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) and, in the case of a corporation, not more than Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) or imprisoned not more than five (5) years, or both. (Section §27-3-79)
