Dear Taxpayer:

The 2011 Insurance Premium Tax annual return due March 1, 2012 is required to be filed online. Additionally, to use a Guaranty Assessment Credit, Coast Area Credit or New Markets Credit brought forward from a previous year, you need to complete a Prior Year Tax Credit worksheet online. The worksheet is due February 1, 2012. Tax credits may be taken only on your annual return.

You have new tax account or identification (ID) numbers. Use these numbers on all future tax returns or communications concerning your tax account(s).

To set-up your account, go to www.dor.ms.gov and click on "Taxpayer Access Point." From there, follow instructions to register for online access. Gather the information below before beginning. If you are not able to complete and submit your online registration, your information is not saved.

- A sole proprietorship needs either a Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN),
- A corporation, LLC, partnership or other needs a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN),
- Contact information for the person or department responsible for preparing and filing tax returns, including name, phone, email, and fax number,
- An email address to receive courtesy notices and information from the DOR. Confidential or financial information will not be sent by email,
- The Letter ID found in the upper, right-hand corner of this letter.
