Miss. Code Ann. Section 27-55-7, 27-55-507, 27-57-7, and 27-59-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, the Commissioner shall require of every person desiring to engage in business within this state, who maintains no permanent place of business within this state, and of every person desiring to engage in the business of Petroleum Distributor, a cash bond or an approved surety bond in an amount sufficient to cover the estimated tax liability for a period of three months (in no case to be less than \$1000); and the Principal herein desiring to so engage in the business of:

The condition of this cash bond is that the Principal obligor herein shall well and truly pay all petroleum taxes, damages, interest and penalties which may accrue on account of said business conducted when same shall become due and payable, and, in the event of failure of Principal obligor to pay all petroleum taxes as due and upon proper assessment, is a charge against any money deposited herein.

Upon termination of said business shown hereinabove and upon determination that all petroleum taxes due the State of Mississippi have been paid, the balance reflected shall be paid to the Principal herein.
