Short explanation of rule/amendment/pepeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/pepeal: This rule was amended to include a more detailed definition of "compensation" and to include additional examples. New paragraph 102 was amended to include a citation and to more closely reflect the language in the law. Old paragraph 102 was removed as retirement income is not taxable. Other minor changes were made.

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 27-7-331, "The commissioner shall also make and prescribe such other rules, regulations and forms as he shall deem necessary or desirable for carrying out the purposes of this article".
