Madison, Miss. – On November 13, 2018, Michael Francis Kimble, 50, entered a plea of guilty to fraudulent statements and representation with the intent to evade a tax imposed by the Mississippi Department of Revenue.

As a condition of his plea, Kimble was sentenced to a term of five years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections; and to pay court costs, fees and assessments in the amount of \$498.50, to be paid within six months after release from custody.

Kimble was prosecuted by the Circuit Court of Madison County.
