The Department of Revenue (referred to as "DOR" or "Department") requested sealed bids from qualified vendors capable of repairing the extend conveyor system, consisting of Conveyor # 1112, Door 8 – S/N 1402, Conveyor # 1212, Door 9 – S/N 1399, Conveyor # 1312, Door 10 – S/N 1404, Conveyor # 1412, Door 11 – S/N 1403, Conveyor # 1512, Door 12 – S/N 1400 and Conveyor # 1612, Door 13 – S/N 1401 located at the Alcoholic Beverage Control Distribution Center (ABC) in Gluckstadt, Mississippi.

DOR will contract for these services with a single vendor for a contract period beginning August 10, 2022 and ending November 10, 2022.

DOR released the Conveyor Repair Invitation for Bid (IFB) # 3160004913 on April 29, 2022. DOR received one (1) sealed bid in response to this IFB. The bid was submitted by FMH Conveyors and was deemed responsive. It was the only bid received and was, therefore, ranked the highest.

The bid submitted by FMH Conveyors was evaluated and deemed responsive and responsible according to the criteria stated in the solicitation.

We announce our recommendation to award a contract to the following vendor subject to approval by the Public Procurement Review Board.

We invite you to contact **Erica Green, Procurement Officer II** if you would like to request a post-award vendor debriefing under Rule 7-113 of the PPRB OPSCR Rules and Regulations. This debriefing is a meeting and not a hearing; therefore, legal representation is not required. However, if you prefer to have legal representation present, you must provide notification prior to the scheduled meeting so that we can also have legal representation present. Your request for debriefing must be received within three (3) business days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **June 14, 2022**. MDOR reserves the right to conduct any such debriefing via a teleconference.

Vendors are reminded that any protests of this decision must be submitted to Erica Green, Procurement Officer II within seven (7) calendar days after the issuance of this notice or no later than June 16, 2022. The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of the protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known),

and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful vendor is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
