The Department of Revenue (referred to as “DOR” or “Department”) requested sealed bids to provide a freight, hauling and delivery plan for alcoholic beverages for the Alcoholic Beverage Control Distribution Center (“Department,” “State” or “ABC”) located at 1286 Gluck Stadt Road, Madison County, Mississippi, to all licensed ABC permittees authorized to purchase alcoholic beverages from the Department to the permitted location of the permittee located in Hinds or Rankin Counties or in the southern portion of Madison County, excluding permitted locations located in the municipal limits of the cities of Canton and Flora.

DOR will contract for these services with a single vendor for a contract period beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2024.

DOR released the Metro Hauling Invitation for Bid (IFB) # 3160004123 on February 2, 2021. In response to the IFB, DOR received four (4) sealed bids.

The following vendors submitted responses to the above solicitation and are listed in the order of ranking from lowest to highest price:

This debriefing is a meeting and not a hearing; therefore, legal representation is not required. However, if you prefer to have legal representation present, you must provide notification prior to the scheduled meeting so that we can also have legal representation present. Your request for debriefing must be received within three (3) business days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **March 12, 2021**.

Vendors are reminded that any protests of this decision must be submitted to **Erica Green Greenwood, Contract Analyst, SR** within seven (7) calendar days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **March 16, 2021**. The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of the protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known), and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful vendor is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
