Question #1:

With reference to the Extended Warranty: “The installer will submit pricing for an additional two years of extended warranty.” Does Mississippi Alcoholic Beverage Control require the additional two years of extended warranty to be included in the total price on Page 40 of the solicitation? Or should this option be a separate price quotation? How will this “option” for the extended warranty be handled during the reverse auction process?

Answer:

Yes, it is a requirement for the additional two years of extended warranty to be included in the total price of the solicitation. We will send out a new bid form with another line added for the extended warranty. However, the total price is what will be considered during the Reverse Auction.

Question #2:

Although we found the attached document, the bid does not seem to be published on the MAGIC system. I had a call with the Help Desk, and they confirmed that the bid is not published on the site. When can we expect the bid to be published there? I would like to review the electronic listing to make sure we are not missing anything.

So, I wanted to clarify if mailing our response is truly needed or if we can just stick to the electronic submission.

Answer:

Question #4:

It is mentioned in the attached document that “the contract shall consist solely of these General Conditions, the Instructions and Special Conditions.” However, there is no section of the attached RFQ document which is labeled as *Special Conditions*. As far as we can tell, there are no details on what the “Special Conditions” are. If you could please clarify where we can find the special conditions, that would be great.

Answer:
